SECTION I

GENERAL

ORGANIZATION

1. MISSION: The Heavy Weapons Section will provide continuous and timely direct and indirect fire support to CIDG forces by destroying in priority those targets that jeopardize the accomplishment of the mission.
2. ASSIGNMENT: This section will be authorized those CIDG camps as directed by Headquarters, VNSF High Command and Headquarters, 5th SFGA, 1st SF.
3. CAPABILITIES: At full strength this unit has the following capabilities:
 - a. Emplacement and employment of the following type weapons.
 - (1) 4.2 inch mortars.
 - (2) 105 howitzer.
 - (3) 106 recoilless rifle.
 - b. Provide timely, close and accurate observed and unobserved indirect fire on hostile forces.
 - c. Provide direct observed fire against known and suspected enemy positions.
 - d. Plan and conduct harassment and interdiction fires.
 - e. Conduct heavy weapons training within its assigned CIDG camp.
4. MOBILITY: Dependent upon outside sources for movement of weapons and equipment.
5. APPLICABILITY: The TOE will be utilized by all CIDG camps authorized light artillery pieces, 106mm recoilless rifles and 4.2 inch mortars in accordance with directives of Headquarters, VNSF High Command and Headquarters, 5th SFGA, 1st SF.

EQUIPMENT

1. This table is the authority to requisition and issue in accordance with procedures directed by Headquarters, 5th Special Forces Group (Airborne), 1st Special Forces.

2. Individual allowances for all grades are listed in Section III.

3. Allowances of equipment authorized herein may be decreased or omitted at the discretion of the VNSF and USA Special Forces Detachment Commanders. Equipment excess to the authorized allowances will not be requisitioned without prior approval of Headquarters, 5th Special Forces Group (Airborne), 1st Special Forces.


