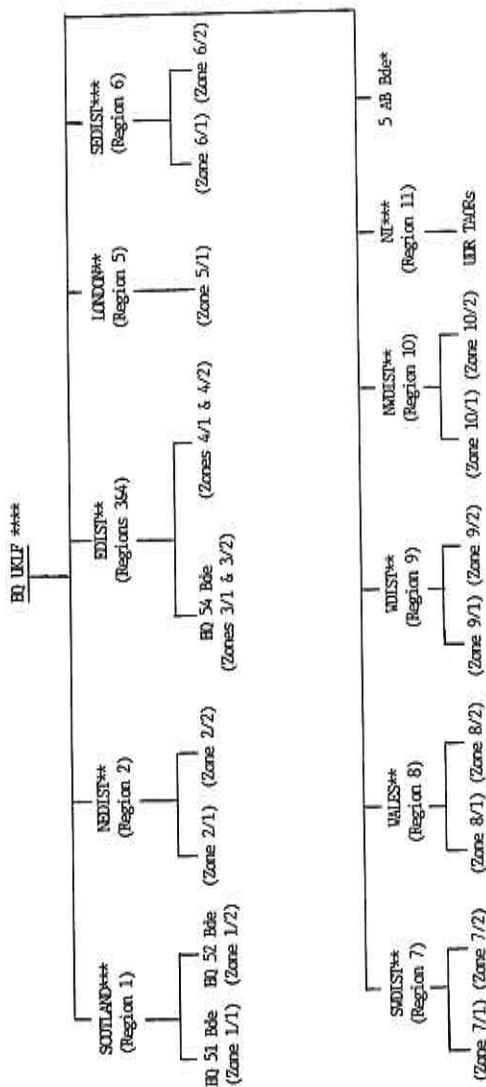
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UKLF HOME DEFENCE REGIONS AND ZONES



UKLF CHAIN OF COMMAND IN WAR

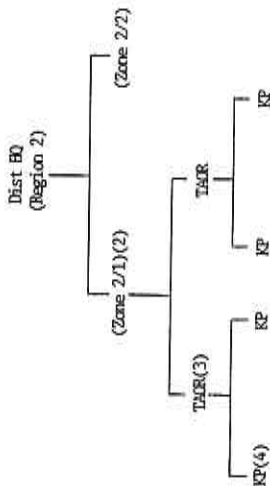

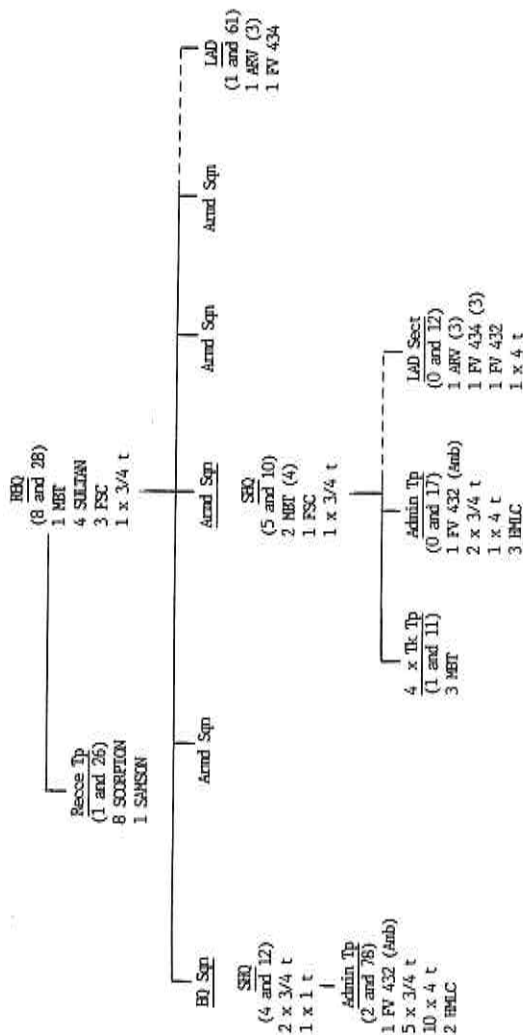
BRITISH PRICES BELIZE (1)
