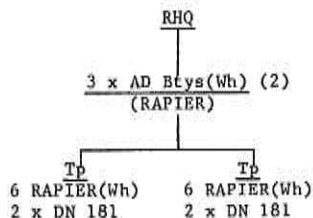
FD REGT (LT GUN) (1)



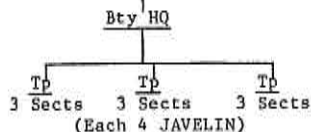
