SECTION I

GENERAL

ORGANIZATION

1. MISSION.

- a. Interdiction of VC/NVA routes of infiltration and lines of communication.
- b. Conduct border surveillance operations.
- c. Conduct company size small scale operations against enemy base areas.
- d. Conduct ambushes, raids and clearing operations within the camp TAOR.
- e. Conduct operations in support of assigned Camp Strike Force (CSF) Combat Reconnaissance Platoons (CRP).
- f. Participate in joint operations with elements of adjacent CIDG camps, Mobile Strike Force (MSF) units and Free World Military Assistance Forces (FWMAF).
- g. Through accomplishment of a through f above, provide security for population bases within the camp TAOR and deny enemy access to population resources.

* This table supersedes TOE CIDG/CS-1, dated 30 September 1968.

2. ASSIGNMENT. Authorizations for each CTZ will be determined by Headquarters, 5th Special Forces Group (Airborne), 1st Special Forces.
3. CAPABILITIES.
 - a. Conduct company size small scale conventional combat operations.
 - b. Conduct ambushes and raids.
 - c. Act as reaction force to hard intelligence.
 - d. Conduct joint operations with other CIDG units and FWMAF.
 - e. Control and provide security to local populace.
 - f. Support the POLWAR program through assistance in civic action projects.
 - g. Provide defense for installation to which it is assigned.
4. APPLICABILITY. This TOE is applicable to all CIDG camps authorized the Camp Strike Rifle Company for use in the Camp Strike Force role.
5. MOBILITY. This unit is foot mobile.

EQUIPMENT

1. This table is the authority to requisition and issue in accordance with procedures directed by Headquarters, 5th Special Forces Group (Airborne), 1st Special Forces.
2. Individual allowances for all grades are listed in Section III.
3. Allowances of equipment authorized herein may be decreased or omitted at the discretion of the VNSF and USASF Detachment Commanders. Equipment excess to the authorized allowances will not be requisitioned without prior approval of Headquarters, 5th Special Forces Group (Airborne), 1st Special Forces.
4. This table authorizes the M-16A1 Rifle and the M-79 Grenade Launcher. In the event these weapons are not available, the Cal .30 M2 Carbine and the Cal .30 Browning Automatic Rifle will be issued as in lieu of items.
5. Basic loads will be determined by TA 1-68, dated 30 November 1968.


