d. Limited radio relay communication.

e. Messenger and message center service for division headquarters.

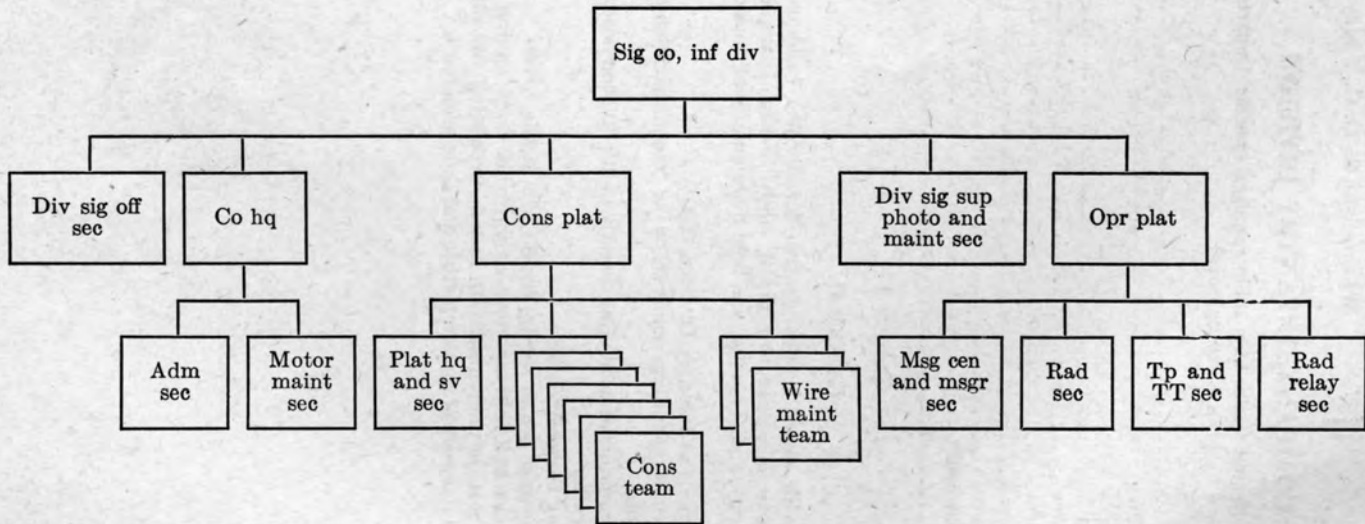
f. Signal supply service and field maintenance of Signal Corps equipment.
